Impact of Socio Economic Development upon Demographic Processes Egypt, 2000.

Many of the Developing Countries are suffering at present from poor socio –economic conditions, high rate of population growth, widespread illiteracy, especially among females, unemployment even among educated persons and lower capital income.

This study aims to assess the degree of socio-economic development at the governorate and regional levels for Egypt, to identify the levels of fertility and mortality as indicated by different measures, and investigate their association with the degree of socio-economic development, and to estimate the volume and direction of internal migration among governorates and the association of migration teams with both place of origin and place of destination and the level of socio-economic development. It uses a descriptive analysis to explore the degree of socio-economic development in different governorates and regions. The study depends mainly on the final results of the last Census of 1996.
