Assessment of Child Situation in Egypt (1995-2007)

This study focused mainly on examining the situation of Egyptian children and its changes over time (1995-2005).

The study dealt with the following.

- Estimating the number and proportion of children aged 0-17 years up till 2021 for the planning purposes.
- Examining child health situation particularly for those aged 0-5 years.
- Identifying child education till the secondary level.
- Investigating the different types of violence and exploitation of children.
- Studying the possibilities of achieving the millennium development goals (MDGs) especially those directed to improving child situation.

The study used bivariate analysis based on cross tabulation for child mortality, morbidity, female circumcision, child education, and multivariate analysis using logistic regression model.
