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Determinants of the Demand for Children in Egypt, 1995 – 2008. (Towards Achieving the Replacement Level Fertility).

The goal of the study to examine:

The pace of fertility in Egypt in order to achieve the replacement level as a major policy objective based on comprehensive analysis of the determinants of the demand for children.

The study tries to examine the levels, trends and differentials of fertility in Egypt during the period 1995 – 2008.

To identify the demographic and socio-economic determinants of the sustained fertility level.

- To identify the determinants of the demand for the children in Egypt.
- To suggest special relevant policy issues which implicate for future action.
- The study depends on data derived from the Egypt demographic health survey, of 1995, 2000, 2005, and 2008.

The multi – variate analysis adopts two models according to the mauler of the dependent variables the first multiple regression analysis, the second model, logistic regression analysis.

Finally, data analysis in did by the statistical package for social sciences (SPSS) using data of the EDHS, 2008.
