Differentials and Determinants of Maternal Health Care Utilization in Uganda, 2006.

The goal of the study is to analyze the demographic and socio-economic differentials and determinants of maternal health care services utilization in Uganda.

The study tries to examine the recent utilization levels of maternal health care services available for women in reproductive age 15-49 years.

- To examine the differentials of utilization of maternal health care services provided to women in reproductive age 15-49 years in terms of antenatal childbirth and postpartum period.
- To identify demographic and socio-economic determinants for antenatal, childbirth and postpartum care services utilization.

The study depends on the data derived from UDHS 2006 raw data.

The study uses both descriptive and analytical approaches to reach the desired objectives.
