Levels, Trends and Determinants of Fertility in Yemen, 1991-2003.

The objectives of this study are to draw a profile for the levels and pattern of fertility in Yemen during the period 1991-2003; to examine the differentials and proximate determinants of fertility in Yemen; to investigate the socio-economic determinants of fertility in Yemen; to examine the effect of family planning on fertility; and to suggest some policy issues to decrease fertility and to enhance the use of family planning contraceptives.

The study depends on the Yemen family health survey (YFHS, 2003), the study used lined multiple regression models to descriptive and analytical approach.
