The study aims to examine levels of family planning knowledge among Egyptian women using "the value of the knowledge of Family Planning Index" (KFPI); to indicate how the level of family planning knowledge is affected by other related factors; to indicate the effect of level of family planning knowledge on the reproductive attitudes through:-

- Assessing the relationship between the level of family planning knowledge and the indicators of the demand for children.
- Assessing the relationship between the level of family planning knowledge and the attitudes about the ideal birth interval.

and finally, to indicate the extent to which the level of family planning knowledge affects the practice of family planning through assessing the relationship between the level of family planning knowledge and some indicators of family planning practice.

This study depends on the Egyptian Demographic and Health Survey (EDHS) of year 2008.
