The Demographic Determinants of Poverty: (the Case Study of Yemen).

This study examined the levels, trends and determinants of the incidence of poverty in Yemen between 1998 and 2005-2006, based on data captured in nationally representative surveys. The study aims to highlight the current status of Yemen by current levels of demographic and socio-economic characteristics and the change over time.

To show the changes in the characteristics of the poor toward (education, health, labor force ...etc).

To overview the current interventions and policies of the government toward eradicating poverty (short-terms& long terms).

This study depends on analyzing the available data of YHBIES 2005/06 through cross-tabulation and simple frequencies to draw a descriptive profile on poverty and its differentials in Yemen.

The study identified also the main determinants of poverty through multivariate analysis mode
