**Child Labor in Egypt by Region 2010. (316).**

The study attempted to find out the characteristics of the child labor and their parents and to examine the environmental conditions of child labor specially these who are working in the high-risk works.

The main objectives of this study can be summarized as follows:

- To examine the levels and trends of child labor in Egypt.
- To analyze the socio-economic and demographic characteristics of child labor and their parents in Egypt by region.
- To examine the regional environmental conditions of child labor in general and specifically the hazards facing child labor.

The author depended on raw data of the National Child Labor Survey (NCLS) for Egypt which was carried out in April/May 2010 by CAPMAS with the Financial and Technical assistants of the ILO International Programme on the Elimination of Child Labor (IPEC).

Both the descriptive approach, which depends on cross tabulation and figures based on secondary data analysis, and an in-depth analytical approach involve a binary Logistic Regression Models are used.

The descriptive aspects cover simple analysis using rates and percentages to examine the prevalence and differentials of child labor.
