Women Empowerment and Child Education in Egypt, 2008. (312)

The objectives of the study are:

- To examine the patterns of women's empowerment indicators in Egypt.
- To profile child education in Egypt.
- To investigate the relationship between women's empowerment, child education, child nutrition and contraceptive use in Egypt.

The study depends on data derived from the Egypt Demographic and Health Survey (EDHS, 2008), and the Multinomial Logistic Regression Analysis revealed the eight most important factors related to women empowerment in order.

The study used the Logistic Regression Analysis to describe the indicators scoring system to constructer, Egypt geographically, the socio-economic level index, exposure to media, child nutrition, women contraceptive use, and women empowerment indicators.
