Differentials and Determinants of Child Morbidity and Nutritional Status in Egypt.

This study tries to identify the demographic and socio-economic determinants of morbidity in the form of infections, anemia and malnutrition in Egypt.

The study meets some points:

- To identify demographic, socio-economic, housing and feeding determinants of infant and child health indices
- To suggest policy issues to decrease morbidity and to improve anemia and nutritional status among Egyptian infants and children. The study uses the data of Egypt Demographic and Health Survey 2000 (El-Zanaty 2001). It depends on two methods of analysis using the Statistical package for social sciences (SPSS), and both the descriptive and logistic regression analyses.
