Differentials and Determinants of Child Morbidity and Nutritional Status in Egypt.

This study tries to identify the demographic and socio-economic determinants of morbidity in the form of infections, anemia and malnutrition in Egypt.

The study meets some points:

- To identify demographic, socio-economic, housing and feeding determinants of infant and child health indices
- To suggest policy issues to decrease morbidity and to improve anemia and nutritional status among Egyptian infants and children. The study uses the data of Egypt Demographic and Health Survy2000 (El-Zanaty 2001). It depends on two methods of analysis using the Statistical package for social sciences (SPSS), and both the descriptive and logistic regression analyses.
