Education impacts on early marriage in Sudan (2014).

- To examine socioeconomic and demographic factors contributing to age difference between spouses.
- To identify the demographic and socioeconomic determinants of early marriage in Sudan.
- Make programmatic recommendations that will help policy makers design interventions to mitigate the problems of early marriage.

The author depended on the Sudan Household Health Survey, SHHS, 2014.

The author used Logistic Regression Analysis and the techniques of Multiple Regression Analysis to analyse data.

Finally, we need to use mass media to increase the awareness of the whole community about the consequences of early marriage on girls themselves, expanding the family planning services to reach the uncovered families.
