Levels, Trends and Determinants of Unemployment among Young People in Egypt (aged 15-29) during to period 2006-2010.

This study attempts to put forward a number of recommendations on the principals that should guide policy to solve the unemployment problem, and to establish the basic elements that policies need for their design and implementation to be successful.

The main objectives of this study are:

- To study the levels and trends of unemployment among people in Egypt.
- To study the employers requirements towards their needs in the newly recruited persons.
- To review the governmental and non governmental organizations' efforts in solving the unemployment problem especially among young people.

The Census 2006 and Labor Force Survey by CAPMAS in 1995, 2000, 2006 and 2010 are used for data.

The study used both descriptive and in depth analysis.

The multivariate techniques are applied using Statistical Package for Social Science SPSS.
