The Impact of Poverty on Women and Child Health in Mauritania, 2007. No. [281]

The aim of this research is to examine the impact of poverty on woman and child health as well as its contribution to selected socio-economic, demographic, and environmental factors in Mauritania.

The study depends on the raw data taken from the Multiple Indicator Cluster Survey (MICS 3) 2007.

Both descriptive and multivariate approaches were used in this research.

An application of multivariate analysis using logistic regression model was used to examine the effect of the selected variables; such as wealth index, education and place of residence of parents on woman and child health.
