Migration Change in Fayoum Governorate, Egypt (1986-1996).

Migration has become an important livelihood strategy for many poor groups across the world.

The main aim of this research is to study the changes that occurred in the level and patterns of interregional migration of Fayoum governorate and other governorates of Egypt between the latest two censuses 1986 and 1996.

The study implies number questions the important ones are:-

- What is the impact of the interregional Fayoum migration changes on the poverty level improvement of Fayoum society?
- What is the impact of changes in migration remittances on the progress of employment situation of Fayoum Community?
- What is the impact of the changes of Fayoum interregional migration on the development of the households living conditions?

These questions address the issue of the adaptation to the change in socio-economic circumstances that accompanied relative great migration flows from certain community like Fayoum governorate. So the study will attend to:

Quantify some of the salient features of the change in and out migration to and from the study area within the period 1986-1996.

Analyse the change in rural migration streams of Fayoum within the period 1986-1996

The study used: the 1986 and 1996 population and housing census, CAPMAS.

Human development report 1994 and 1998 national development institute and Statistical year book 2004.
