This study tries to examine the levels and trends of family planning practice in Bangladesh, to examine the demographic and socio-economic differentials of contraceptive use& discontinuation in Bangladesh to determine the demographic and socio-economic determinants of contraceptive use& discontinuation in Bangladesh and to analyze the levels and trends of discontinuation of contraceptive use and method switching in Bangladesh

The study is mainly based on the descriptive and analytical techniques to analyze the data of BDHS 1999-2000 by using the multivariate analysis technique which is employed for the advanced statistical analysis of this study.
