Women Status and Reproductive Behavior in Tunisia and Yemen

The present study has attempted to examine the relationship between women's status and reproductive behavior among Tunisian and Yemeni women.

The main data sources for this study were Tunisian family health survey of 2001 and Yemeni health survey of 2003. Both surveys were carried out as a part of pan Arab project for family health (PAPFAM) implemented by league of Arab states (LAS) in collaboration with some Arab and international organizations.

Overall levels, patterns of both women's status and reproductive behavior and its differentials were analyzed through descriptive analysis. In addition, multivariate analysis was employed using regression analysis technique (multiple and logistics) using SPSS software package.
