Evaluation of the Impact of Family Planning Program on Fertility in Egypt, from 1966-2000.

Family planning is the conscious effort of a couple to regulate the number and spacing of birth through artificial and natural methods of contraception.

FP. Connotes contraception control to avoid pregnancy and abortion, but it also includes efforts of couples to induce pregnancy.

This study focuses mainly on the impact of family planning program on fertility in Egypt.

More specially, the study will try to meet the following objectives:-

- To present the goals of family planning programs as the main instrument of population policy in Egypt.
- To evaluate the impact of family planning programs on fertility in Egypt from 1966-2000.
- To determine the demographic and socio-economic factors that impact fertility in Egypt.

The study depends on path analysis logistics regression analysis.
