Impact of Female Education on Fertility in Egypt, 2005

This Thesis attempts to examine the levels and trends of education, specially female education during the period 1970-2007, to examine the relationship between selected determinants of female education, fertility and investigate the effect of intermediate variables associated with female education and fertility such as current age of women, age at first marriage, women work status and female approvals of family planning methods .The study depends on Egypt Demographic And Health Survey (EDHS,2005) it also depends on path analysis as statistical technique to analyze the direct and indirect relationship between dependents and independents variables.
