Factors Affecting Mother's Anaemia in Uzbekistan, 1996.

The health of mothers and children is a major indicator of any country. The health of women and children represents a big investment in the services of a country's health system. Women are a key component when determining the quality of life considerations. The study will try accomplishing the following objectives:-

- Describe the epidemiology (at risk mother, environment) of iron deficiency among mothers.
- Identify the socio-economic and demographic factors related to mother's anaemia.
- Investigate the association between mother's and child's anaemia.
- Investigate the association between mother's anaemia and infant mortality.

The study has used multivariate regression analysis to identify the most determinant factors in mothers' and children's anaemia and SPSS 11.0. (This is a comprehensive statistical software system designed to handle all steps in an analysis ranging from data listing, tabulations and descriptive statistics to complex statistical analysis).
