**High Fertility and its Implications on the MDGs Attainment in a Post-Conflict Country, Rwanda.**

The major objectives of this study are:

- To give a better understanding of the context and causes of high fertility in Rwanda
- To analyze the factors that affect fertility in Rwanda.
- To study the effect of high fertility on MDGs attainment.
- To suggest the measures and policies interventions to remedy the situation.

The main sources of data are the RDHS (Rwanda Demographic and Health Surveys ) 1992, 2000 and 2005 along are derived from Rwanda Ministry of Finance and Economic Planning (MINICOFIN ) report and Rwandan Ministry of Health (MONISANTE ) report.

In this study, description as well as multiple regression analysis are used to examine key factors that are mostly associated with high fertility in Rwanda.
