Levels, Trends, Determinants and Consequences of Female Marital Adolescent in Egypt (1995-2008)

The study attempts to study the levels and trends of age at first marriage through the period of 1995 to 2008 and identify the determinants of age at marriage.

- To investigate the effect of married adolescent females on fertility.
- To analyze the effect of married adolescent females on child mortality.

The study relies heavily on raw data from the Egypt Demographic and Health Surveys of EDHS, 1995-2008.

The descriptive analysis and the multivariate techniques are applied using Statistical Package for Social Science (SPSS).
